'Satyanarayana Memorial Young Achievers Award'

Medal and Certificate

The Rao-Bahadur Kaizer-E-Hind Dr. Kanapaka Satyanarayana Memorial Young Achievers Award, was started in 2016, in the memory of Late Dr. K Satyanarayana. Scientific papers in the various subspecialties of Anatomy are to be presented at the NCAS conference; in a special session named after the award.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Age of the presenting author should not be more than 40 years by the last day of the calendar year concerned. (Supported by documentary proof).
- 2. Presenting author should be the sole author or the first author.
- 3. The presenting author must be registered as an annual/life member of NCAS.
- 4. Topic of the study may be concerned with any of the subspecialties of Anatomy.
- 5. Paper must be accompanied by a certificate from the HoD, stating that it is an original work done by the author himself/herself.
- 6. The author should send a complete manuscript of the paper to the Organizing Secretary. The name of the author and the Institute should not be disclosed anywhere in the paper. The author and the Institutional details should be on a detachable separate page.
- 7. The Organising Secretary will send these to Dr Patnaik VVG via email followed by the hard copy of the speed post, but without the name of the author or the institute.
- 8. All the papers will be scrutinized by Dr Patnaik VVG or an Anatomist authorised by him. Following which these will be shortlisted to a maximum number of 10 papers.
- 9. These 10 papers will be presented at the NCAS conference, in a special session named after the award; in front of a 3 member committee to be constituted by Dr Patnaik VVG, at the time of the conference.
- 10. If no paper is found suitable for the award, the award shall be carried forward to the next year when two awards may be given.
- 11. Family members of Late Dr. K. Satyanarayan will be awarding the Medal and the Certificate in the function during the conference.
